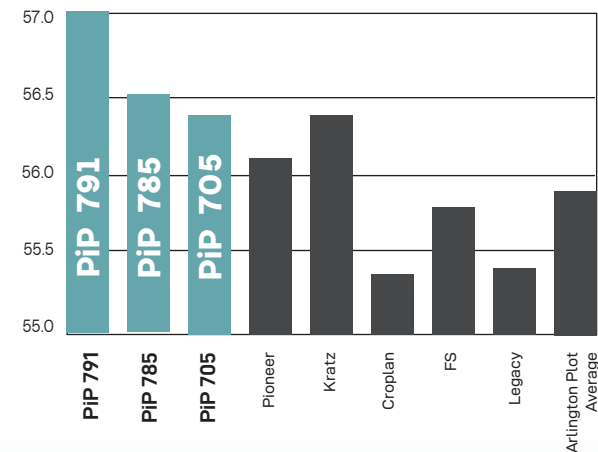

True Corn/Soybean/Wheat (C/S/W) Crop Rotation
